OLD BUSINESS:

Understanding the Juvenile Justice System

New RFP submitted by Ed Cue of CADA. Drama Kings were paid for performances. The schools have been very happy with the addition of the Drama Kings. Report from Ed Cue submitted as attachment. Commission members expressed many thanks to Mr. Cue for integrating the Drama Kings into the UJJS program. The goal is for the program to be inundated with request from schools.

Teen Court had to reduce 3 ½ positions. \$46,000 budget shortfall for teen court in the coming fiscal year.

After School Program Inventory

Commissioner Dullea has spearheaded an inventory of the after school programs available through the schools located in Santa Barbara County. Mr. Dullea asked for the assistance of other commission members in contacting schools and obtaining such information. Commissioner Weinstock has sent information regarding Lompoc schools.

Probation Update

Chief Probation Officer Patti Stewart presented the current state of budget cuts. She will be presenting again to the Board of Supervisors. The probation department has put together a list of cuts that could be made on a tiered basis. It appears they are looking at 3.3 million in reductions.

Probation department would like to begin a pilot program for adults. Report and Resource Center. Department is hopeful to have monies reinstated so this program is able to get off the ground.

The primary cuts by the state will hit the Prop 36 monies. One half of the officers assigned will need to be cut.

The Commission inquired as to whether or not there has been a study of those kids who have completed the Drama Kings ART program. The department indicated stats are currently being collected.

MADIC (Making a Difference Intervention Collaborative)

Keith Terry and Michael Cardenas spoke to the Commission about Ystrive and MADIC. MADIC works with high risk or gang risk kids.

The members of this collaborative include: All for One, Primo Boxing, Turf to Surf, Youth in the Media, Los Compadres, and Ystrive. Grass root organizations. The goal isto be able to share data with schools and probation and thereby become more effective and serve more kids in the streets. This group is in need of funding and learning how to effectively apply for grants. MADIC did receive a grant from the Bauer Foundation. These groups were already working together but are now formalizing the collaborative.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
