#### **Juvenile Probation Department**

- Deputy Chief Probation Officer (DCPO) Shawn Small updated the commission on the following:
- Title 15 Revision Implementation:
  - 1. All Title 15 priority chapter revisions due March 31
  - 2. Major revisions items: Programs, Recreation and Exercise; Room Confinement; Use of Force
  - 3. BSCC pre-inspection set for May 16
- Enhanced Programing Implementation:
  - Mandates one hour of specified programing per day
  - Implemented tracking forms
  - Working to identify supplemental and alternative programing options
- NCCHC Accreditation Analysis
  - Began required one-year pre accreditation review period starting January 1<sup>st</sup>
  - Underwent WellPath internal pre-inspection on February 27; Initial reports look good
  - Submitting an update to Board of Supervisors in April
- Other Projects and Initiatives
  - Camp Program Revision
  - Master Control Room personnel change from Sworn to civilian staff
  - Scheduling of software implementation
  - o Construction projects for second tier barriers and latrine remodel
  - Camera Upgrade to web based for both hall and camp

## **Commissioner Reports**

- Chair Palera informed the commission that Chief Heitman was chosen as one of four probation Chiefs to sit
  on a working group looking into Juvenile Hall Utilization thru out the state.
- New Commission applications will be looked into and a process will be set up to confirm they get to Judge
- The Commission reviewed the reports for the Hall and Camp and suggested changes that will be included before submission by chair.
- Chair Tanney informed us there was a need to reinspect group home that was deficient on last inspection. A date will be set and volunteers will be asked for.
- Chair Palera would send out the dates for the next meeting.
